Report on the Audit of Financial Results

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying financial results of Frick India Limited ("the Company") for the quarter ended 31st March, 2024 and the year to date results for the period from 1st April, 2023 to 31st March, 2024 (the "Statement") attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us the Statement:

- (a) are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations in this regard; and
- (b) give a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS) and other accounting principles generally accepted in India of the net profit and other comprehensive income and other financial information for the quarter ended 31st March, 2024 as well as the year to date results for the period from

 1st April, 2023 to 31st March, 2024.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing (SAs) specified under Section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013, as amended (the Act). The Management and Board of Directors of the Company are responsible for maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding of the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial results that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the Statement, the management and the Board of Directors are responsible for assessing the Company's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the Board of Directors either intends to liquidate the Company or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

The Statement includes the results for the quarter ended 31st March, 2024 and 31st March 2023 being the balancing figure between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year ended 31st March, 2024 and 31st March 2023 and the published un-audited year to date figures up to the third quarter of the respective financial year, which were subjected to a limited review by us, as required under the Listing Regulations.

Our opinion on the same is not modified in respect of above matters.

The above results were reviewed by the Audit Committee and have been approved and taken on record by the Board of Directors at its respective meetings held on 24.05.2024 and a limited review of the same have been carried out by the statutory auditors of the company.

The Company is primarily engaged in the business of manufacture, supply and execution of Industrial Refigeration and Air conditioning systems. As the basic nature of these activities is governed by the same set of risks and returns, therefore, has only one reportable segment in according to IND AS 108 "Operating Segments".

The Board of Directors have recommended a dividend of viz. Rs. — per share (Previous Year Rs. 4.00 per share i.e. 40%

of face value) subject to the approval of shareholders in the ensuing annual general meeting.

The figures for the previous periods/year have been regrouped / rearranged, wherever necessary. The figures for the quarter ended 31st March 2024 and 31st March 2023 are the balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of full financial year and reviewed year-to-date figures upto the third quarter of the financial year.
